The Parade Route

- * Kickoff is at 77th street and Central Park West at 8:30 AM.
- * The parade turns at Columbus Circle onto Central Park South.
- * The parade veers south onto 6th Avenue.
- * The final turn will be onto 34th Street, and end in front of Macy's Herald Square.
- * Avoid watching from 6th Avenue between 34th and 38th



History of the Parade

- * The first parade was in 1924. It was originally known as the Macy's Christmas Parade and featured animals from the Central Park Zoo.
- * In 1927 the parade debuted its signature giant balloons. Felix the Cat was the first ever character balloon.
- * The only interruption, since its start, was from 1942 through 1944 due to a rubber and helium shortage. Macy's donated the balloons to the war effort.
- * The parade was televised for the first time locally in 1946 and nationally in 1947.
